Guidelines to apply for an Art Scholarship

The Art Scholarship is applied towards tuition when a student enrolls as an Art major at the College. To apply, students must submit a portfolio that includes between 14 to 20 recent artworks. The portfolio can be reviewed in digital format or in person at the New Rochelle campus.

Select artworks that provide a comprehensive visual overview of your work, indicating the depth and breadth of your experience and technical abilities, as well as showing a level of consistency and focus in terms of conceptual development. You can include drawings, paintings, collages, ceramics, photographs, or designs.

Digital Portfolio with Image List

Submit between 14 and 20 digital images attached as separate jpg files. Include a separate **Image List** of artworks that has the numerical inventory listing with the title, date, media and dimensions completed for each of the artworks submitted.

Digital Images

File Name: Label files with numbers in the order you would like them to be viewed, with your last and first name and matched to the image list. Example: **01_Doe_Jane.jpg**

Image dimensions: 1,240 pixels on longest dimension.

Resolution: 72 dpi

Format: JPG

File Size: no larger than 2.MB each

Image List

Example: 1. Title, year, media, dimensions.

Optional

A two-paragraph statement about the conceptual development or ideas in the artwork is optional.
