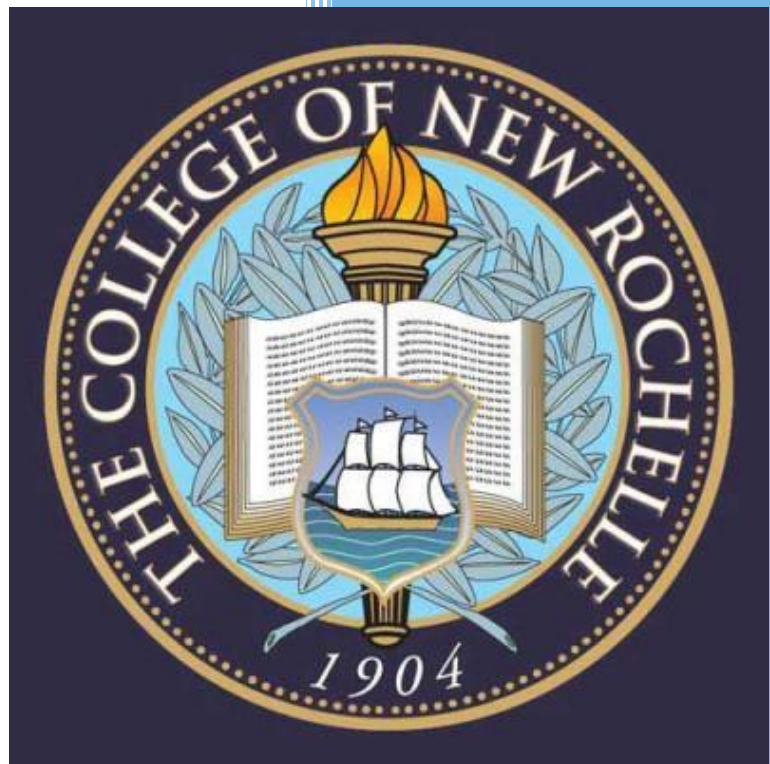


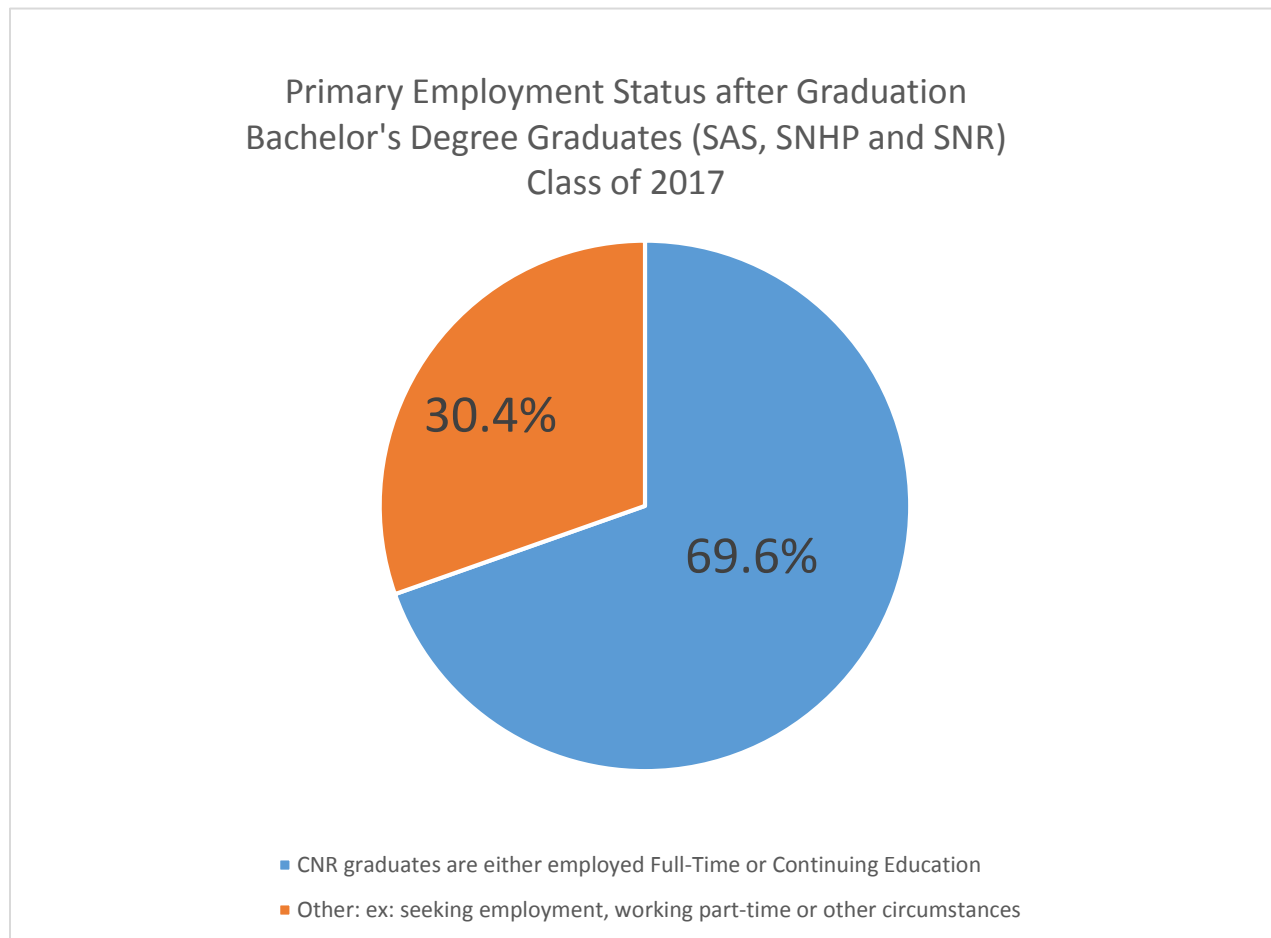
Career Outcomes Report Class of 2016 and Class of 2017



**BACHELOR DEGREE GRADUATES
CLASS OF 2017**

Each year, The College of New Rochelle's Office of Career Development conducts an annual follow-up survey with recent graduates to measure postgraduate job placement and graduate school after graduation. The **Class of 2017** Career Outcomes online survey was administered from *April 2017 – March 2018* to all Bachelor's Degree Graduates from The School of Arts and Sciences (SAS), School of Nursing & Health Care Professions (SNHP), and The School of New Resources – Adult Learner Program (SNR). The total number of graduates is 664. This survey resulted in aggregate response rate of 13.9%.

Post-Graduation Employment and Education



69.6% of the Class of 2017 have a desirable post-graduation outcome.

- 55.4% had full-time employment
- 12.0% planned to continued their education
- 2.2% are employed full-time and continuing education

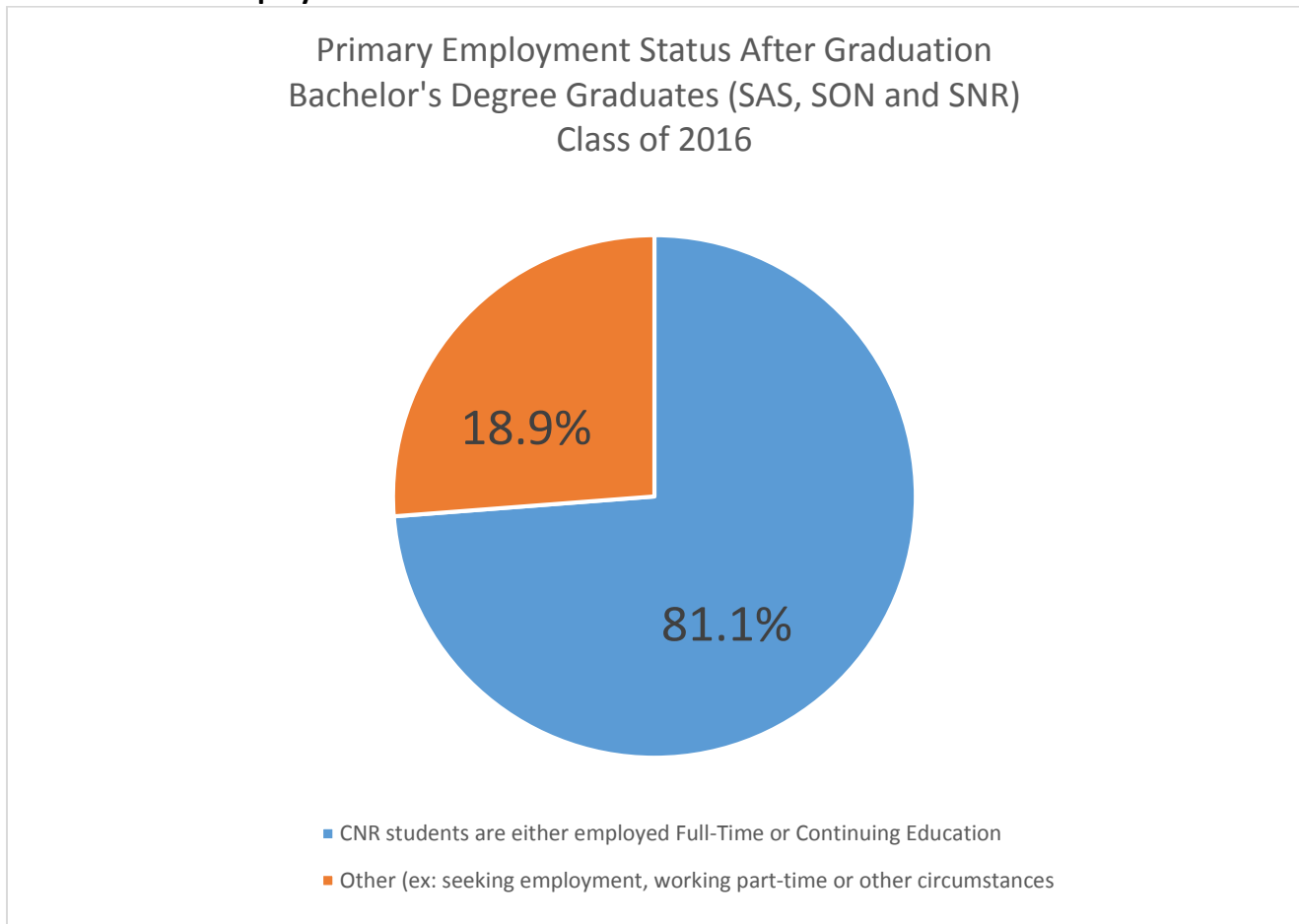
30.4% of the Class of 2017 classified under "OTHER"

The **Class of 2016** Career Outcomes online survey was administered from **June 2017-April 2018** to all Bachelor's Degree Graduates from The School of Arts and Sciences (SAS), The School of Nursing & Health Care Professions (SNHP) and The School of New Resources– Adult Learner Program (SNR). The total number of graduates is 698. This survey resulted in aggregate response rate of 7.6%.

Post-Graduation Employment and Education



81.1% of the Class of 2016 have a desirable post-graduation outcome.

- 73.6% had full-time employment
- 7.6% planned to continued their education

18.9% of the Class of 2016 classified under "OTHER"

- 7.6% had part-time employment
- 3.8% were seeking employment
- 7.5% had "OTHER" circumstances

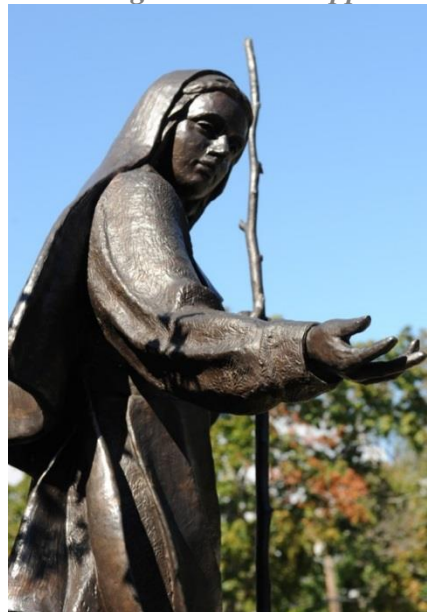


