**THE ACCELERATED FIVE SEMESTER FULL TIME SECOND DEGREE PROGRAM** is ideal for students who have already completed a bachelor's degree in another field and want to transition to a career in nursing. The College of New Rochelle School of Nursing uses a caring-healing model as its standard, so you will learn to provide aid to patients that is both effective and compassionate.

#### **ACCELERATE YOUR CAREER**

The five-semester program track is designed for students looking to earn a BSN quickly and efficiently. Applicants must have completed a non-nursing bachelor's degree as well as all 25 credits of liberal arts and science prerequisites. Classes are full-time, beginning with a summer session and continuing through the next five semesters (ex. Fall, Spring, Summer, Fall, Spring).

All applicants and students in this program are required to hold a bachelor's degree with a GPA of 3.0 or better, and a grade of C+ or better. Prerequisite courses listed below:
