5. COMPLETE YOUR HOUSING APPLICATION

6. SEND IN OFFICIAL DOCUMENTS

In order to complete your enrollment, you'll need to submit all final and official high school or college transcripts. If your decision was rendered based on unofficial SAT or ACT scores, the official test scores must be submitted as well. Official test scores can be submitted either through your high school guidance office, as part of your transcript or directly from the testing agency. The College of New Rochelle SAT school code is 2089, while the ACT school code is 2712. Transcripts can be sent to the Office of Admission or submitted through Parchment at www.parchment.com. These documents are required in compliance with federal and state financial aid regulations.
